Each student will receive a topic for their own research study and is provided with feedback. Attendance and preparation are required for course participation.
 The assignments mainly consist of the participants conducting a research project.
 Circa 12 text pages (+/- 10% length) of a review on a specific research topic (excluding references, tables, figures, etc.)
• 20-minute presentation about the research project plus discussion.
 There will be three fixed meetings.
 The supervisor may be consulted for conceptual and methodological questions during the assignment time.
